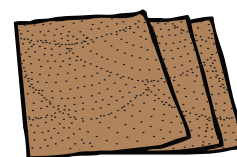
**Idea:** Use a branch to make a handle for a gardening tool box.



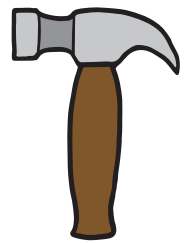
1" Forstner Bit

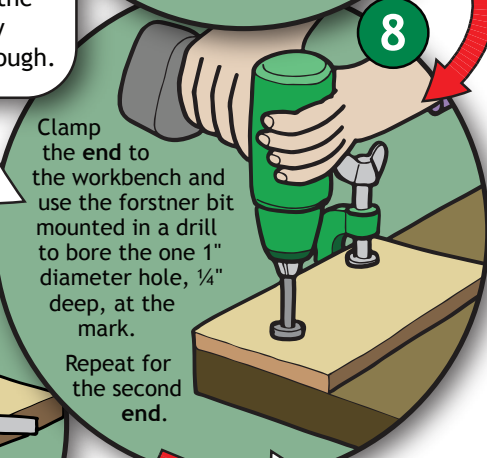
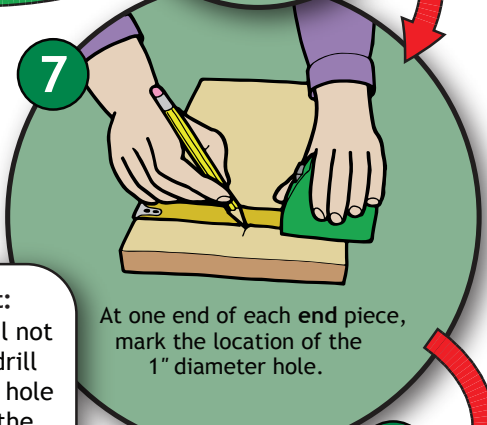
## Making the parts



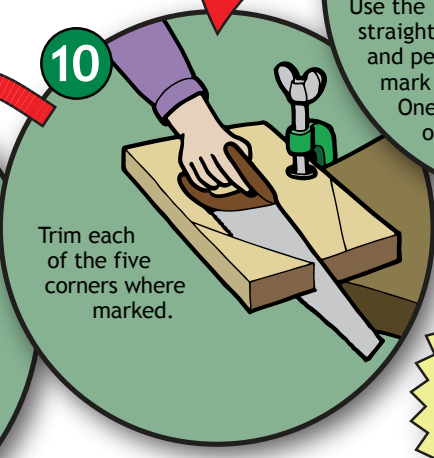
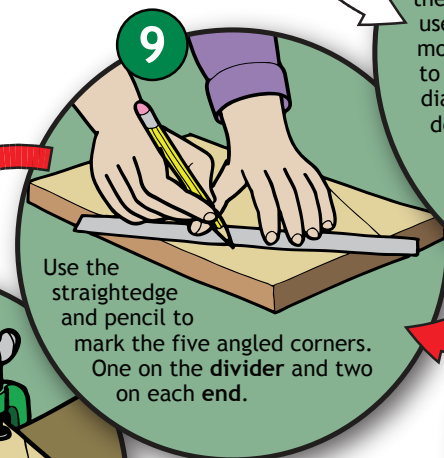
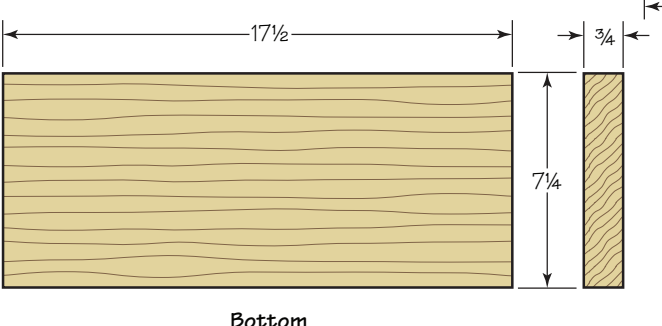
All measurements are in inches.



**Important:** Be careful not to drill the hole all the way through.

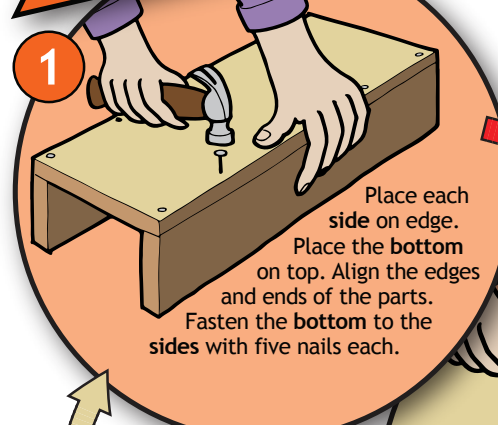


**Remember:** Wear your safety goggles when using a drill.

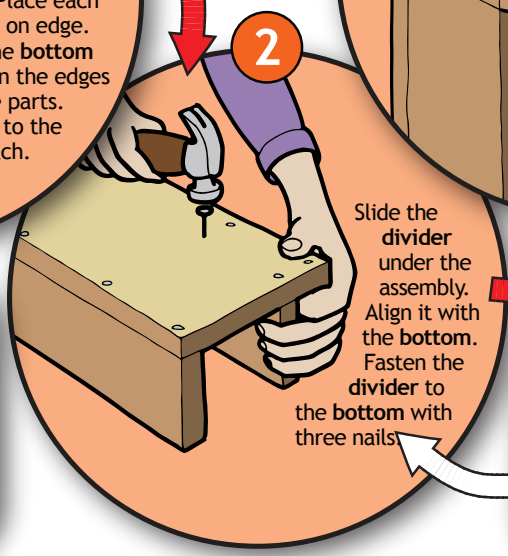


Congratulations you've made a toolbox

**Note:** Each nail is placed 3/8" in from the edge of the board.



**Tip:** The divider can be located wherever you want. To use it to hold your saw, it should be 3/4" from one of the sides.
